A Tentative Order (TO) issuing amended Water Quality Certification and Waste Discharge Requirements for stream maintenance activities will be considered by the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board at its February 9, 2022, meeting (see Attached). **Written comments on the Tentative Order or objections to this action must be submitted no later than January 14, 2022, by 5:00 p.m.**

The TO amends Order No. 2021-0005, issued to the Napa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District and Sonoma County Water Agency for their Stream Maintenance Programs (SMP), and the San Mateo County's and the Contra Costa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District's Routine Maintenance Programs (RMPs), to include Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District's (Midpen) RMP and applies to stream maintenance activities conducted pursuant to an approved SMP or RMP Manual (Manual). The TO applies to stream maintenance activities conducted pursuant to an approved SMP or RMP Manual (Manual). Each Manual describes routine stream maintenance activities conducted in a manner that enhances ecosystem processes while helping to mitigate flood related hazards.
