This is a message from the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco

The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit amendment for nearly all municipal wastewater dischargers in the region in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. The draft permit amendment would reduce effluent and influent monitoring requirements for select pollutants and require municipal wastewater dischargers to provide supplemental funding to the San Francisco Bay Regional Monitoring Program for Toxic Pollutants and Trace Substances to support additional studies for constituents of emerging concern.

The Regional Water Board will hear comments on the tentative order during a meeting starting at 9:00 a.m. on December 15, 2021. The last date for written comments is 5:00 p.m. on November 15, 2021. The Regional Water Board will hear oral testimony but will not accept written comments after this date.
