

Resolution of the Board of Directors (“Board”) of the Guadalupe-Coyote Resource Conservation District (“District”) Adopting a Environmental and Social Justice Policy

Whereas, the Board wishes to recognize, apply, and uphold environmental and social justice within its purview and provide the same support for its partner organizations; and

Whereas, the Board also seeks to provide equal opportunity for everyone, particularly those with the greatest need, including equity pertaining to participation in District efforts, outreach and public comments for stakeholders and members of the public and the District’s commitment to issues such as public outreach and public participation for marginalized communities/areas; and

Whereas, the Board reviewed the draft Environmental and Social Justice Policy at its meeting on June 3, 2021, and wishes to adopt the policy.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board hereby adopts the Environmental and Social Justice Policy, effective upon adjournment of its June 3, 2021 Board meeting, and rescinds any previous versions of this policy previously adopted by the District.
