- **Tools & Equipment** – Our crews come with all the hand and power tools necessary.
- **Vehicle Fleet** – We have a fleet of over 20 vehicles from passenger vans to flatbed trucks to dump trucks.
- **Professional** – Our crews wear uniforms, show up on time, and work safely and courteously. All crews include an experienced Crew Supervisor.
- **State of California Certified Community Service Corps** – The SJCC is certified annually by the State Resources Agency to ensure that it meets high standards for operation and performance.
