The Guadalupe-Coyote Resource Conservation District (GCRCD) is an independent special district of the state of California led by a volunteer Board of Directors and regulated by Division 9 of the California Public Resources Code. Its mission “to provide education and technical assistance to constituents and watershed stakeholders to sustainably manage soil, water and wildlife with the best available science.”

**GCRCD Directors are appointed to four-year terms by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors and serve without compensation.**

To qualify for a Director position, an applicant must have a demonstrated interest in natural resource conservation, be a registered California voter, and meet at least one of the following requirements under PRC Section 9352:

- a) A resident of the district who owns real property in the district; or
- b) A resident of the district who has served as an associate director to the district for two years or more; or
- c) A designated agent of a resident landowner within the district.

Additionally, as public officials, directors are required to submit an annual Statement of Economic Interests to the Fair Political Practices Commission (Form 700) to help identify and avoid potential conflicts of interest.
